Interested Bermudians between the ages of 18 and 40 are invited to submit a letter of motivation including:

- Indication of why this apprenticeship interests you
- Age
- Availability (days and time of day)
- Reasons for interest in the programme
- Any relevant experience
- Name and contact information of two character references who are not related to you
- Contact information including email address, telephone number, and mailing address

The successful apprentice should exhibit openness and respect for non-traditional learning environments; and a passion for Bermuda's traditions and heritage.
